# METHODS TO GROUND SYSTEM REFORM EFFORTS IN THE EXPERIENCES OF WOMEN/SURVIVORS

- Purpose of CCR:
  - identify gaps
  - identify potential solutions
  - build changes into policies, protocols
  - procedures, laws, forms etc. to eliminate gaps and improve outcomes for victims, community, and the offender as well

# **FOCUS GROUPS**

- Women talk about their experience and impact on their lives
- Themes identified
- E-learning example: focus groups • women discuss the experience of being battered and then arrested as offenders
  - what it's like to become victim-defendant.

#### TRACKING AND MONITORING

- Provides statistical analysis:How many/ how long:
  - arrests, prosecutions, convictions?
  - Identifies systemic trends and/or individual compliance problems

*E-learning Example: If more than* 10%-20% of DV arrests are women, there is a problem.

# **TEXT ANALYSIS**

- Examine written directives
  - Law
  - Policy
  - Procedures, forms, screens, checklists, routing slips, etc.
- Examine work products
  - Police reports
  - Dispatch-911 recordings/ transcripts

#### **OBSERVATION & INTERVIEWS**

- Ride-alongs, court watches, other methods to observe practitioners at work
- Interviews about the work
- Can learn much from observing and interviewing practitioners
- •What do they know about the problem?
- What don't they know? Are the following the law? Departmental policy? Are the guided by their department to identify risk, history, self-defense?
- What don't you know re: all of the above?

# MAPPING

- Chart that identify each institutional action that takes place in a case
- Finding out where in the process there needs to be change

- Moves from broad to specific statement
- How a specific problem can be fixed

- On-going conversation & dialogue with women and advocates
- Talking with other communities
- Systems response concerns procedure
