## Protocol 1—Card 2 UNSAFE FOR CALLER TO SPEAK FREELY OR STAY ON THE LINE

## Stay alert to changing safety needs – Verify that it is safe for caller to stay on the line.

Inform caller that officers have been notified – Respond to caller's need to know when officers will arrive.

Stay respectful, calm, and reassuring.		
Caller NOT SAFE to answer questions	<b>Call interrupted</b> Assume caller cannot speak freely	Hang-up call – Open line
<ol> <li>Can you stay on the phone without talking to me? YES: Reassure the caller: help is one the way.</li> <li>NO: Set down the phone and go to another location. Please leave the line open.</li> <li>Would you like me to talk with the other person there? YES ↓</li> <li>Possible suspect on the line</li> <li>Who am I speaking with? What is happening?</li> <li>Attempt to keep the person on the line and allow time for the squad to respond.</li> <li>Remain calm and respectful.</li> <li>Avoid arguing.</li> <li>Refrain from language that appears to take sides.</li> <li>DO NOT SHARE:         <ul> <li>What caller or others have said</li> <li>Why police were called</li> <li>Other information about the situation</li> </ul> </li> <li>In all calls, stay alert to suspect on the line. Listen for click, breathing, talking.</li> </ol>	<ul> <li>Disconnected after initial contact: Call back <ul> <li>No answer or machine</li> <li>Do not leave message.</li> <li>Relay any details about the call prior to disconnect, including screams, threats, or other background noises.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Answered by caller <ul> <li>Be alert to suspect on the line</li> <li>Ask yes/no questions.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Answered by another adult party <ul> <li>Be alert to suspect on the line.</li> <li>Ask to speak to the other person there.</li> <li>Ask yes/no questions.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Caller says "everything's okay now" <ul> <li>Can you safely answer yes/no questions?</li> <li>YES: Do you need police help now?</li> <li>Confirm address &amp; phone.</li> <li>Ask yes/no questions.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Be alert to any background sounds.</li> <li>Check whether phone number or address is a known location for prior domestic abuse calls.</li> <li>Gauge potential safety risk on a call back.</li> <li>Call back. <ul> <li>Be alert to suspect on the line.</li> <li>Proceed with caution.</li> <li>Attempt to confirm location and phone number.</li> <li>Ask yes/no questions.</li> <li>Adult says children playir on the phone.</li> <li>Age and name of chill</li> <li>Ask to speak to the child</li> <li>Is everything okay?</li> <li>Do you need help?</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
